ACCORDING TO SECTION 2 (2) OF THE REPRESENTATION OF PEOPLE ACT, 1951 A COUNCIL CONSTITUENCY, A LOCAL AUTHORITIES' CONSTITUENCY, A GRADUATES' CONSTITUENCY AND A TEACHERS' CONSTITUENCY SHALL BE TREATED AS A CONSTITUENCY OF A DIFFERENT CLASS (.) UNDER SECTION 62 (3) OF THE REPRESENTATION OF PEOPLE ACT, 1951, NO PERSON CAN VOTE IN MORE THAN ONE CONSTITUENCY OF THE SAME CLASS (.) UNDER SECTION 62 (4), NO PERSON CAN VOTE IN THE SAME CONSTITUENCY MORE THAN ONCE (.) SUBJECT TO THESE PROVISIONS, A PERSON IS NOT PROHIBITED FROM VOTING IN CONSTITUENCIES OF DIFFERENT CLASSES SUBJECT TO ELIGIBILITY (.)
