The attention of the District Collectors, Srikakulam and Chittoor is invited to the references cited and they are informed that School Education Department was consulted on the issue. They have opined that as per rule 12 of G.O.Ms.No.1 Education(SE) Department dated 1-1-1994 all appointments of either teaching & non-teaching staff by aided and non-aided Schools shall be subject to approval of competent authority i.e. Dist. Educational Officers in respect of Primary & Upper Primary Schools and the Regional Joint Directors of School Education in respect of High Schools. They have also stated that this is based on teacher/pupil ratio of 1:40 in respect of Schools other than Primary Schools.

2. In view of this, the Collectors are requested to obtain the approved staffing pattern of such schools from the Regional Joint Directors / District Educational Officers having jurisdiction over their districts and use this as the basis of verifying form 19 applications filed by teachers of such institutions.

3. In consultation with Higher Education Department, the status of private colleges is clarified as follows:

In respect of unaided Junior Colleges, Secretary, Board of Intermediate Education prescribes the staffing pattern. In respect of aided and Government Junior Colleges, Commissioner, Intermediate Education is the concerned authority. In respect of Private, un-aided Degree Colleges, Secretary, State Council of Higher Education and in respect of Aided colleges and Govt. Colleges, Director, Collegiate Education are the concerned authorities.

4. Information on the approved staffing pattern in Colleges may be obtained from these authorities or their local / regional representatives and used as the basis for verification of applications filed by members of staff of these institutions.

5. The Collectors, Srikakulam and Chittoor and all other Collectors (except Collector, Hyderabad) and the Commissioner, M.C.H. are requested to take necessary action accordingly. It should be ensured that all applications for inclusion in Form 19 are dealt with immediately after such verification and formal orders issued in all cases of rejection.
