The following notification of the Election Commission of India, New Delhi, No. 100/AP-LC/1/2010 (1), dated 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2010 / Jyaistha 3, 1932 (Saka) is published:-

## NOTIFICATION

**No. 100/AP-LC/1/2010 (1):-** Whereas, the seat of Smt. M. Lakshmi Devi, in the Legislative Council of the State of Andhra Pradesh, elected by the Members of the Legislative Assembly of the State, has become vacant on 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2010 by the reason of her death, before the expiration of her term of office which was upto and including the 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2011; and

WHEREAS, a bye-election is to be held for the purpose of filling the vacancy so caused;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of section 151, sub-section (1) of section 39 and section 56 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the Election Commission of India hereby -

(A) calls upon the members of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Andhra Pradesh to elect, before 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2010 (Saturday) and in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the rules and orders made thereunder, a person for the purpose of filling the said vacancy in the Legislative Council of the State;

(B) appoints with respect to said election,-

- (a) the 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2010 (Monday), as the last date for making nominations;
- (b) the 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2010 (Tuesday), as the date for the scrutiny of the nominations;
- (c) the 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2010 (Thursday), as the last date for the withdrawal of candidatures;
- (d) the 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2010 (Thursday), as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken; and

(e) the 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2010 (Saturday), as the date before which the election shall be completed; and

(C) fixes the hours from 9.00 A.M. to 4.00 P.M. as the hours during which the poll shall, if necessary, be taken on the date specified above, for the election.
