The following Notification dated 26th March, 2007 / 5 Chaitra, 1929 Saka, of
the Election Commission of India, New Delhi is published:

NOTIFICATION

No.322/AP-LC/2007 : - WHEREAS, the Commission, vide its notification
dated 15th February, 2007, announced the programme for elections to the Andhra
Pradesh Legislative Council from 8 Graduates', 8 Teachers' and 21 Local Authorities'
Constituencies and

WHEREAS, the date for taking of poll for the above elections was fixed as 17th
March, 2007 and the date before which the elections should be completed was earlier
fixed as 26th March, 2007 and later shifted to 28th March, 2007.

WHEREAS, complaints have been received in the Commission alleging
violation of secrecy of ballot papers in many polling stations for Local Authorities'
Constituencies of the State and

WHEREAS, video clipping and reports obtained by the Commission from various sources have prima facie established the allegation for which open enquiry has been initiated and

WHEREAS, final decision regarding repoll in respect of Local Authorities Constituencies will be taken only after getting the reports from the concerned officers which may take a few more days and as such counting for all Local Authorities' Constituencies has been kept on hold by the Commission. This, in turn, will require the date for completing the elections from these constituencies to be extended beyond 28th March, 2007.

Now, therefore, the Commission has decided that while the date before which the elections shall be completed will remain unaltered i.e. 28th March, 2007 in respect of elections from Graduates', Teachers' Constituencies and by the Members of the Legislative Assembly, the date before which the elections for the Local Authorities' Constituencies shall be completed will now be 25th April, 2007
