The following Notification dated the 24th April, 2007 / Vaisakha 4, 1929 (Saka) of Election
Commission of India, New Delhi is published.

NOTIFICATION

No.322/AP-LC/2007:- WHEREAS, the Commission vide its notification dated
15th February, 2007, announced the programme for elections to the Andhra Pradesh
Legislative Council from 8 Graduates', 8 Teachers' and 21 Local Authorities'
Constituencies; and

WHEREAS, the date of poll for the above elections was fixed as 17th March,
2007 and the date before which the elections should be completed was earlier fixed as
26th March, 2007 and later shifted to 28th March, 2007; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons stated in its Order no. 322/AP-LC/2007-PLN-III(LACs) dated 14th April, 2007, the Commission has declared void the poll taken on 17-3-2007 at some of the Polling Stations of 8 Local Authorities' Constituencies and has directed a fresh poll to be taken at those Polling Stations on 25th April, 2007 and counting of votes for all the 18 Local Authorities' Constituencies shall be taken up on 27th April, 2007, as such, this will require the date for completing the elections from these Constituencies to be extended beyond 25th April, 2007.

Now, therefore, Commission, in exercise of its powers under section 30 read with section 153 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 hereby directs that in respect of the said 18 Local Authorities' Constituencies, the date before which the elections shall be completed, shall be 5th May, 2007.
