S.O. (E):-In pursuance of section 12 of Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the
President is pleased to call upon the elected members of the Legislative Assembly of the State of
Andhra Pradesh to elect, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the rules and
orders made thereunder, members for the purpose of filling the seats of six members of the
Council of States whose term of office is due to expire on the 21st June, 2010 on the expiration of
their term of office.

APPOINTMENT OF DATES FOR VARIOUS STAGES OF BIENNIAL ELECTIONS TO THE COUNCIL OF STATES (RAJYA SABHA) FROM ANDHRA PRADESH, 2010 AND FIXING OF HOURS OF POLL.

The following notification of the Election Commission of India, Nirvachan Sadan, Ashoka Road, New Delhi – 110001, dated 28th May, 2010 / Jyaistha 07, 1932 (Saka) is republished:

NOTIFICATION

No.318/CS-AP/2010 (1) :- Whereas, the President of India has, by notification issued under section 12 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951) and published in the Gazette of India on 28th May, 2010, been pleased to call upon the elected members of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Andhra Pradesh to elect six members to the Council of States;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of sub-section (1) of section 39 and section 56 of the said Act, the Election Commission of India hereby –

(A) appoints, with respect to the said election –

- (a) the 4th June, 2010 (Friday), as the last date for making nominations;
- (b) the 5th June, 2010 (Saturday), as the date for the scrutiny of the nominations;
- (c) the 7th June, 2010 (Monday), as the last date for the withdrawal of candidatures;
- (d) the 14th June, 2010 (Monday), as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken; and
- (e) the 17th June, 2010 (Thursday), as the date before which the election shall be completed; and

(B) fixes the hours from 9.00 A.M. to 4.00 P.M., as the hours during which the poll shall, if necessary, be taken on the date specified above for the election.
