**PRESS NOTE**

Dated: 29-09-2006

The A.P. Legislative Council Act, 2005 (Act 1 of 2006) which has been passed by the Parliament, provides for the creation of a Legislative Council for the State of Andhra Pradesh. The Council will have 90 seats of which 8 will have to be filled from the graduates' constituencies, 8 from the teachers' constituencies, 31 from the local authorities' constituencies, 31 by the Members of the Legislative Assembly and 12 by nomination by the Governor. The Government have today commenced the preparation of Electoral rolls for the Graduates' and teachers' Constituencies. A person will be disqualified for registration in the Electoral Rolls if he

- (a) is not a citizen of India; or
- (b) is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent court; or
- (c) is for the time being disqualified from voting under the provisions of any law relating to corrupt and illegal practices and other offences in connection with elections.

The Election Commission of India has decided to prepare the electoral rolls of the concerned Graduates' and Teachers' Constituencies as required under section 27 of the Representation of the People Act, 1950.

The revision of electoral roll of the concerned Graduates' and Teachers' Constituencies shall be undertaken with reference to **1<sup>st</sup> November 2006** as the qualifying date in accordance with the following programme-

**PROCEDURE FOR ENUMERATION TO GRADUATES CONSTITUENCIES:**

The qualifications prescribed for a elector in a Graduates' Constituency are;

- (i) on the qualifying date i.e. 1.11.2006, he should have been ordinarily resident in the constituency;
- (ii) he should have been for at least 3 years, before the qualifying date i.e. 1-11-2006, either a Graduate of a University in the territory of India or in possession of any of the qualifications notified by the State Government as equivalent to that of a graduate of a University in India.

**Procedure for enumeration for Graduates' Constituencies: -**

- (i) The updated list of qualifications equivalent to that of a Graduate specified by the Government of Andhra Pradesh concerned for voters in the Graduates' constituencies is planed at **Annexure II**
- (ii) The eligibility of a person for enrolment in a Graduates' Constituency is to be determined having regard to provision of Article 171 (3) (a) of the Constitution and Sections 27 (3) (a), 27 (5) (a) and 27 (6) of the R. P. Act 1950. Accordingly, a person who has been, for at least three years before the qualifying date,(01.11.2006), a graduate of any University in the territory of India or has been in possession of equivalent qualifications prescribed in the list referred to in sub para (i) above and is ordinarily resident of the constituency is entitled to be registered as an elector in a Graduates' Constituency.
- (iii) The Commission has prescribed that the applicants should submit the following documents in support of their educational and other qualifications so that their claim for inclusion of names in a Graduates' Constituency in Form 18 under Rule 31(3) of Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, could be accepted by the ERO/AERO:-
  - (a) The degree, diploma certificate in original granted by the university or institution concerned or any copy thereof duly self attested; or
  - (b) copy of an entry in the Government

record or a certificate issued to a Graduate employee by the Gazetted Head of Office on the basis of entries in Government records in his custody or a copy of an entry in the record of Statutory Bodies, Corporations or Public undertakings specifying the degree, diploma or certificate possessed by the claimant duly attested by the Head of the office concerned ; or (c) an attested copy of the card of registration as registered Graduate issued by the University, a certified copy of the relevant entry in the list of registered Graduates, the Roll of Advocates, the register of Medical Practitioners, the register of Chartered Accountants, the register of Engineers maintained by Institute of Engineers, etc.; or (d) an affidavit by the claimant supported by certificate from the Registrar of a University, or the Principal of a College affiliated to University or from the Head of the Department of such College under whom he had studied; or (e) the mark sheet in original granted by the university or Institution concerned or any copy thereof duly self attested, provided that there is clear indication there that claimant has passed the concerned examination.

- (iv) The eligible persons should apply for enrolment of their names in the prescribed Form 18 along with documents listed in sub-para (iii) above. (It may be noted that mere reference to an

entry in the existing electoral roll will not be repeat will not be taken into account for determining the eligibility of a person for enrolment in the electoral rolls).

(v) Every person making an application in Form 18 shall be required to furnish his degree or certificate or mark sheet, in original, in support of his eligibility as per the following procedure: -

(a) In cases where the applicant directly submits his application in person before the Designated Officer duly appointed for the purpose, he will produce the original degree/certificate/mark sheet before the Designated Officer. The Designated Officer will scrutinize the degree/certificate/mark sheet and after satisfying himself record either "*Verified with original and found correct*" or "*Verified with original and found not correct – Rejected*". The Designated Officer will then affix his signature, full name and PIN number on the application as mark of a summary enquiry and retain a photocopy (only attested by him) of the original document furnished by the applicant and forward the application to the ERO.

(b) In cases where the application is sent by post to the ERO/AERO alongwith attested copies of the degree/certificate, the ERO will forward the same to the Revenue Divisional

Officer (RDO), incharge of the area where the applicant stays. The RDO will, in turn, issue a notice to the applicant to appear either before him or a Designated Officer appointed for the purpose in the Sub-division, in person, alongwith his original certificate. Such notice will be issued by registered post or hand-delivered with proper acknowledgement due. On the appointed day of the hearing, the applicant will produce his original certificates and the Designated Officer will then proceed with his enquiry as per sub- para (a) above and affix his decision as laid down therein. The application will then be forwarded after completion of the enquiry by the RDO to the ERO/AERO concerned.

- (vi) Any application where original certificates have not been submitted will be summarily rejected by the ERO as incomplete.
- (vii) Applications in bulk whether submitted in person or by post, shall not be considered for inclusion by the ERO.

### **PROCEDURE FOR ENUMERATION IN TEACHERS' CONSTITUENCIES**

- (i) The eligibility of a person for enrolment in a Teachers' constituency is to be determined having regard to the provisions of Article 171(3) (c) of the Constitution and sections 27(3)(b), 27(5)(b) and 27(6) of the Representation of the People Act, 1950. Accordingly, a person shall be entitled to be registered as elector in a Teachers' Constituency, if (a) he has been engaged in teaching, within the six years immediately before the qualifying date (1st November, 2006 in the present case),

for a total period of three years, (b) he has been so engaged in teaching for the said period in any of educational institutions not lower in standard than that of secondary school, (c) such educational institutions not lower in standard than that of secondary school have been specified as such by the State Government, with the concurrence of the Election Commission, by notification in the official gazette, and (d) the person concerned is ordinarily resident within the territorial extent of the Teachers' Constituency in which he seeks enrolment.

- (ii) The list of all educational institutions specified by the State Government as not lower in standard than that of a Secondary School, is planed at

- (iii) In order to ensure that no ineligible teachers are included in the rolls, the EROs may obtain a list of teachers eligible for enrolment in the electoral rolls from the Institutions concerned. As mentioned above the list of eligible educational institutions are available in **Annexure - III**

- (iv) The engagement of a person in teaching in the specified educational institutions **for at least three years within the preceding six years as stated above may be either in one continuous spell or in broken spells and further, may be either in one institution or more institutions, but all such institution must be specified institutions as mentioned, above.** Therefore, it is immaterial whether a person, who has been so engaged in teaching for a total period of three years in one or more specified educational institutions, has been employed in those institutions as teacher on regular basis or on an ad-hoc basis **but he should be a whole time teacher against a sanctioned post and not engaged on a part-time**

**basis as the condition for 3 (three) years engagement in teaching cannot be fulfilled by a part-time teacher. Please note, Part-time teachers are not eligible**

- (v) Every application in Form 19 by a person seeking enrolment in Teachers' Constituency shall be accompanied by a certificate from the Head of the Educational Institution certifying the engagement of the person concerned as a teacher for a total period of three years within the last preceding six years against a sanctioned post. The format for the certificate will be as follows:-

- (vi) The certificate of the Head of the Educational Institution in the above format should be considered enough by the ERO to determine the eligibility of the applicant.
- vii) Applications in bulk whether submitted in person or by post, shall not be considered for inclusion by the ERO.

Every teacher who has been engaged in teaching for the qualified period in an educational institution coming up to the prescribed standard will be entitled to be registered as an elector, irrespective of whether he is teaching in the primary section, middle section or any other section of the institution.

It is not necessary that the education institution in which an eligible elector is employed should also fall within the same constituency. The eligibility to be enrolled in a particular constituency shall be determined with reference to his place of ordinary residence and not the place of work.

The applications should be in Form 19 prescribed under Rule 31 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960.

Along with the application the applicant should enclose a statement attested by the Head of the Institution in which the applicant is serving, showing the continued/intermittent period of his service as a Teacher for 3 years together with the name / names of the Institution / Institutions in which he so served during that period. In the case of a person who is not engaged in teaching on the date of submission of the application, the statement should be attested by the Head of the Institution in which he last served as a Teacher.

Printed Application Forms of 18 and 19 for the purpose of Graduates' and Teachers' constituencies, will be made available shortly to the public on payment of cost in the Offices of Collectors, R.D.Os, D.R.Os., and

Commissioners of Municipalities / Corporations. It is not compulsory to use printed forms supplied by the authorities. Forms downloaded from the web site [www.ceoandhra.nic.in](http://www.ceoandhra.nic.in) , cyclostyled / photocopied, hand written or privately printed can also be used so long as they conform to the statutory format. However, these forms should be on A4 size white paper and should not contain the name / symbol or any distinguishing mark of any party/organization printing/supplying the same. The applications may be sent by post or delivered in person at any one of the above offices within whose jurisdiction the applicant was ordinarily residing on 1.11.2006. The last date for the receipt of application is 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2006 and it will not be possible to include in the electoral rolls the names of persons whose applications are received after that date.

In respect of both the Graduates' and Teachers' constituencies, the voter should be ordinarily resident in the constituency on the qualifying date i.e., 1.11.2006. According to the provisions of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 a person is deemed to be ordinarily resident in a constituency only if he physically and actually resides in that constituency on the qualifying date. There can be no constructive residence on the ground of owning or possessing a house.

A person cannot be registered as a Voter more than once in any constituency or in more than one constituency of the same category. But a person can, if duly qualified, be registered as a voter in constituencies of different categories. Graduates' and Teachers' Constituencies of the Council will be treated as falling under different categories for this purpose.

For example a graduate teacher with requisite qualifications will be entitled to be registered both in a Graduates' Constituency and in a Teachers' Constituency.

## **QUALIFICATIONS FOR ENROLLING AS A ELECTOR IN LOCAL AUTHORITIES CONSTITUENCIES**

### QUALIFICATIONS:

For the purpose of elections to the Legislative Council of a State in any local authorities' constituency, the electorate shall consist of members of the following Local Authorities exercising jurisdiction in any place or area within the limits of that constituency.

1. Municipal Corporations
2. Municipalities
3. Nagar Panchayats
4. Cantonment Boards
5. Zilla Praja Parishads
6. Mandal Praja Parishads

For Local Authorities Constituencies, there is no qualifying date. Electoral rolls of these constituencies are not revised. But they are kept up-to-date by correction being made by the Electoral Registration Officers concerned on the basis of the changes which are brought to their notice by the Executive Officers of the Local Authorities concerned. Members of Local Authorities need not file any applications. However, if any member wants to file an application he can do so in Form 17 which is available with the Electoral Registration Officers or can be download from [www.ceoandhra.nic.in](http://www.ceoandhra.nic.in). Further, where an application for inclusion, deletion, or correction of entries is received by the Electoral Registration Officer, he shall refer such application to the Chief Executive Officer of the Local Authority concerned and on receipt of information in relation there to from the Chief Executive Officer to Local Authority concerned take further necessary action for inclusion or correction of entries.

According to the Delimitation of Council Constituencies (Andhra Pradesh) Order, 2006 (**See Annexure-IV**), the State of Andhra Pradesh has been divided into the following constituencies and the number of seats allotted to each constituency is shown against each:

The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 11th January, 2006 and is hereby published for general information:—

THE ANDHRA PRADESH LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT, 2005  
No. 1 OF 2006

[11th January, 2006.]

An Act to provide for the creation of Legislative Council for the State of Andhra Pradesh and for matters supplemental, incidental and consequential thereto.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Fifty-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Council Act, 2005.

Short title.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, each of the words and expressions used herein and not defined but defined in the Representation of the People Act, 1950, shall have the same meaning as in that Act.

Definitions.

3. (1) As from such date as the President may by order appoint, there shall be a Legislative Council for the State of Andhra Pradesh; and as from that date, in sub-clause (a) of clause (1) of article 168, after the words "States of", the words "Andhra Pradesh," shall be inserted.

Creation of Legislative Council for Andhra Pradesh.

(2) In the said Council, there shall be 90 seats of which—

(a) the numbers to be filled by persons elected by the electorates referred to in sub-clauses (a), (b) and (c) of clause (3) of article 171 shall be 31, 8 and 8 respectively;

(b) the number to be filled by persons elected by the members of the Legislative Assembly of Andhra Pradesh in accordance with the provisions of sub-clause (d) of the said clause shall be 31; and

(c) the number to be filled by persons nominated by the Governor of Andhra Pradesh in accordance with the provisions of sub-clause (e) of that clause shall be 12.

(3) As soon as may be after the commencement of this Act, the President, after consultation with the Election Commission, shall, by order, determine—

(a) the constituencies into which the State of Andhra Pradesh shall be divided for the purpose of elections to the said Council under each of the sub-clauses (a), (b) and (c) of clause (3) of article 171;

(b) the extent of each constituency; and

(c) the number of seats to be allotted to each constituency.

(4) As soon as may be after such determination, steps shall be taken to constitute the said Council in accordance with the provisions of this Act, the Representation of the People Act, 1950 and the Representation of the People Act, 1951.

In pursuance of sub-section (3) of section 3 of the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Council Act, 2005 (1 of 2006), the President after consultation with the Election Commission, is pleased to make the following Order, namely:-

1. This Order may be called the Delimitation of Council Constituencies (Andhra Pradesh) Order, 2006.
2. The constituencies into which the State of Andhra Pradesh shall be divided for the purpose of elections to the Legislative Council of the State from (a) the graduates' constituencies, (b) the teachers' constituencies, and (c) the local authorities' constituencies in the said State, the extent of each such constituency and the number of seats allotted to each such constituency shall be as shown in the following Table:-
