**PRESS NOTE**

**Dt.06.11.2006**

A meeting with all recognized National and State political parties is conducted today (06.11.2006) to discuss the Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls, 2007 in 22 districts of State (except Hyderabad), Partly Intensive and Partly Summary revision of electoral rolls in 13 Assembly Constituencies of Hyderabad (Municipal Corporation of Hyderabad jurisdiction) and the Issues relating to the Election Procedure for A.P. Legislative Council. The following representatives of political parties participated:

Explained the need of preparation of error free Electoral Rolls and requested the co-operation and active involvement of all political parties in the process.

To know the names of claimants of Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls, 2007 and easy identification of bogus claimants by the political parties the copies of lists in Form-9, 10, 11 & 11A being prepared for addition, deletion, correction and transposition of names will be provided to political parties. Political parties were requested to scrutinize the lists at this stage itself to prevent complaints at a later date ie., inclusions / deletions were made behind without their knowledge.

Further assured to instruct all the District Election Officers / Electoral Registration Officers to supply the dates and timings of Gram Sabha/Ward Sabha meetings to be conducted and requested all the party leaders to attend those meetings for identification of bogus electors and to issue instructions to update the website after disposal of the claims received through e-registration so as to enable the applicant about the status of his claims. Bulk applications are not accepted. A family member can submit applications of his other family members.

In respect of Partly Intensive and Partly Summary revision of electoral rolls in 13 ACs of Hyderabad (Municipal Corporation of Hyderabad jurisdiction), on a request made by Sri Indrasena Reddy (BJP), agreed to provide the list of enumerators appointed with their specific jurisdiction of enumeration.

With regard to preparation of Electoral Rolls for council constituencies clarified that claims can be accepted from those applicants' whose name are missed in the draft roll being published on 22.11.2006 and also from fresh applicants for enrollment in Graduates' and Teachers' constituencies during the period for filing of claims and objections ie., from 22.11.2006 to 07.12.2006. In this regard a press note and clear instructions to all the District Election Officers were already issued on 31.11.2006. Also clarified that bulk applications for Graduates' Constituencies (Form-18) can not be accepted from any institution. All the political parties requested that residence certificate should not be insisted upon.
